



The Data for Nutrition (DfN) Community of Practice (CoP) was launched by DataDENT and partners in March 2020. The DfN community aims to provide “members with opportunities to share knowledge, experience, and questions relevant to strengthening the nutrition data value chain at all levels for the purposes of achieving better nutritional outcomes in low- and middle-income countries.”

The DataDENT team at the Johns Hopkins University, is carrying out a formative evaluation to 1) inform decisions about the continuation of the DfN CoP, and 2) identify ways that the aims, design and administration of the DfN CoP can be improved to better meet your needs as a member and enhance the user experience. Ultimately, we hope that a more responsive DfN CoP will contribute to stronger nutrition information and data systems globally and in turn, better population-level nutrition outcomes.
